
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
























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
























SCRIPT FOR KOKUSAISEI NYUUSHI 2021

Turn your test paper to the next page. Please look at the whiteboard.

You are going to choose 1 picture from the box below. The picture must fit the pattern.

The last letter of each is the first letter of the next one.

Look and circle the picture that fits the pattern.

Let's do an example; please look at one star.

This is a cat. Cat ends with T. This is a Tomato. Tomato starts with T and ends with O. Last is a slide. It starts with S. Which picture should go here? We want one that starts with O and ends with S. That would be....the Octopus.

So, you would circle the paper like this. (demonstrating on the whiteboard as explained) If you make a mistake, please draw 2 lines, like this. And draw your new circle, like this. Please finish this page. You start from Two Star.

Okay, please begin:

Times up. Please put your pencils down.

Please look at the whiteboard. Please look at One Triangle. On this page, you will make pairs from the pictures in the box.

For example, you can pair a raccoon with a deer, like this. Keep making pairs until no more pairs can be made. In this box, we can make 4 pairs. There are now 2 raccoons with no partner. So, in the answer box, we now draw 2 circles, like this. There is now one circle for each raccoon with no partner. It is okay to use your pencils to make the pairs on the test paper, like this. (gesture)

If you make a mistake, please draw 2 lines, like this. Please turn your test papers to the next page. Please finish these 2.

Okay, please begin.

Times up. Please put your pencils down.

Please look at Two Triangles.

On this section, you will make groups from the pictures in the box. For example, you can group a dumpling, an ice cream and hamburger, like this. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

In this box, we can make 6 groups. There are now 2 ice creams not in a group. So, in the answer box, we now draw 2 circles, like this. There is now one circle for each ice cream not in a group. It is okay to use your pens to make the groups on the test paper. If you make a mistake, please draw 2 lines, like this. Please finish these 2. Okay, please begin.

Times up. Please put the pens down.

Please look at the whiteboard.

On this page, you must follow the arrows to get the Robot to the Star.

Please look at One Diamond. For example, here the robot must go Right, Right, Up, Up, something, Up. So, look at the box below and choose the correct arrow to help the Robot. To help the Robot we must circle the Right arrow.

If you make a mistake, like this, please draw 2 lines, like this. And draw your new circle, like this. Please turn to the next page. Please do the next five by yourself. Okay, let's begin.

Please look at the whiteboard and turn your question paper to the same page.

From now, please listen to the stories. Then, answer my questions.

1. How is the weather?

For this question, you must draw a circle in the box under the correct weather picture. In the story, it was snowy, so we draw the circle here. If you make a mistake, draw 2 lines like this. And draw your new circle, like this.

2. What animals played outside?

Ms. Fox, Ms. Cat, Mr. Hamster and Ms. Mouse played outside with Mr. Penguin. So, we circle all these animals, like this.

**3.** What did they do outside?

They made a snowman and went ice skating, so we draw a circle here and here.
